He tells Baek-goem (his boss) to take the wheel and also tells him to run away and gets out of the car to fight Kang-ho but Baek-goem sticks his head out the window and yells "I can't go without you!" He gets out of the car to save Dong-goo from Kang-ho but they both end up getting caught and put in jail; but this is all Dong-goo's misunderstanding. What really happened is that Dong-goo had forgotten to leave the keys in the car so Baek-goem couldn't start the car. When he stuck his head out the window he really yelled, "Hey give me the keys!" The reason he got out of the car was because he saw the keys dangling from Dong-goo's belt and he was trying to get them when they got caught. A wonderful misunderstanding between the boss and his right arm! Because of the whole matter Dong-goo gets sentenced to jail for 2 years and Baek-goem for 5 years. 2 years later, Dong-goo finally
